State Goal 3: Support the development of other skills necessary for student success.

The BGCS CLC will provide students enrichment/recreational/arts/other opportunities to develop a sense of self.

Goal achieved: the CLC offers a wide variety of opportunities for children to support the development of other skills necessary for student success- educating and supporting the whole child. Activities include: enrichment clubs in art and books (reading), recreational opportunities include basketball, multisport club, volleyball, arts- participation in afterschool musical and strings, and the participation in the FIT KIDS program. Additionally, drug/risky behavior prevention curriculum was provided as well as social emotional learning support.
